1. Mass and Confession Times

Weekend Liturgy: Saturdays at 5:00 p.m., preceded by Confessions from 4:00 to 4:45 p.m. Sundays at 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 12:00 noon, and 6:00 p.m.

Weekday Liturgy: Mass or Communion Service, Mondays through Saturdays, at 7:30 a.m. in church, followed by parish devotions in the chapel.

Holy Days: For Christmas, Easter, and Holy Day Mass and Confession schedules, please consult the parish bulletin or the News page of the parish website. Please come and worship with us!

2. Parish Contact Information

Parish Location: We are located on the corner of 195th Street and 115th Avenue in Mokena. The physical address of the parish is 19515 South 115th Avenue. Turn west on 195th Street from Wolf Road and go two blocks to get to the parish. Please come and visit us soon!

Mail Service: Please address all correspondence to St. Mary Parish, Post Office Box 2, Mokena, IL 60448-0002. Please do not use the physical address on any correspondence to the parish. Please only use the post office box address for mailings, due to instructions from the post office.

3. Church Office and Parish Registration

Church Office Hours: Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Evening and weekend hours are by appointment. The church offices are located in the parish center building. The entrance faces east on the circular drive, and has a semicircular glass atrium. After hours, there is a live answering service to answer your phone calls. Parish Registration: Welcome to St. Mary Parish! Please see the pastor after any Mass, or come to the church office during the week to register as a member of St. Mary Parish. Although our parish was established for residents of Mokena, we do accept people from the surrounding area who are committed to regular attendance at Mass and participation in the life of our parish community. 4. Baptisms, Weddings, and Funerals

Baptisms: Congratulations on the (coming) birth of your child! Arrangements for baptisms are made at monthly meetings for (expectant) parents. Please call the church office to register for the meeting and for more information. Baptismal dates are set at these meetings for parents.

Weddings: Congratulations on your engagement! Established parishioners are encouraged to set wedding dates about a year in advance. Our Pre-Cana marriage preparation program is held on a regular basis for engaged couples, to help them prepare to celebrate the sacrament of Matrimony.

Funerals: We are very sorry for the loss of your loved one. Please call the parish office as soon as practical. The time for the funeral will be confirmed through the funeral director of your choice. We will meet with you to prepare for the Funeral, and offer you our bereavement ministry support.
