

Contemporary Music Ensemble: Revised on May 31, 2009

Mission: The contemporary music ensemble provides musical accompaniment to sung prayer, so that a worship environment conducive to developing spirituality, both for the congregation and the musicians, is suitably achieved.

The contemporary music ensemble intends to grow in membership and diversity of instruments to allow creativity and variety in their musical offering.

The use of the piano, guitar, violin, and flute aids the worship and participation of the congregation by providing a prayerful and spiritual contemporary environment for the congregation. From time to time, various instrumentalists are used at other Masses as well.



Organization: The contemporary music ensemble sings at the 9:00 a.m. Sunday Mass throughout the year, at other parish celebrations as requested, and rehearses at least monthly. Long-term commitments to the contemporary music ensemble are expected and necessary for this Music Ministry.

Membership: Each year, the Music Director asks the musicians to propose the names of individuals from their ministry for consideration as music ministry representatives. After consulting with the Pastor, the Music Director selects the representative from this ministry to the Commission.
