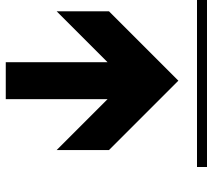

THE FISH ORGANIZATION

FISH is a local, community-based “helping hand” available to residents of Frankfort Township in situations of need. We are Christians of area churches, joined together to help neighbors – be they familiar faces or strangers. Our philosophy is to put faith into action, as we respond to Christ’s teachings about providing food, drink, shelter, clothing and Christian love for people. (Matthew 25:35)

FISH offers food, clothing, counsel, overnight shelter, help with utility bill payments, transportation assistance and referral service to appropriate agencies. At Thanksgiving, Easter and Christmas, food baskets are provided by the Mokena Lions Club, Frankfort Lions Club, Project Share and Berkots Super Foods. At Christmas time, we maintain “FISH Trees” throughout the community so that residents can purchase gifts for FISH clients as well as residents of Trinity Services homes.

All calls to **FISH** are handled through **Crisis Line of Will County (815-469-6166 or 708-479-1399)** 24 hours a day. In turn, Crisis Line contacts a **FISH** volunteer who screens the call and directs the client to appropriate care.

The **FISH Organization** uses as its logo, the fish – an ancient and unique symbol meaning specifically, “Jesus Christ, Son of God, Savior.” The sign of the fish was used by early Christians for identification and communication. The use of this symbol by our **FISH Organization** indicates that Christ is the motivation for our Christian love and caring.

The Mokena-Marley-Frankfort FISH Organization is always in need of volunteers. The hours are flexible and the rewards immeasurable. If you would like to volunteer or if you desire more information about **FISH**, please call or visit the Resale Store.

DIRECTIONS TO RESALE STORE

Rte. 45 (LaGrange Rd.) North of Rte. 30 to 195th St. (Willow) West on Willow to first entrance to Willow Lane Plaza. Enter to right and continue to right, past LA Café & around to back of plaza. Look for FISH symbol on garage door.

FISH RESALE STORE

One visible extension of **FISH** is the local clothing center, housed at 9625 W. 194th Place. Donations of good, used clothing and small household items are accepted each Friday and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Volunteers sort, size, and prepare the clothing for sale. Clothing is available to the general public at reasonable prices and is free of charge to persons in need.

Proceeds are then directed through the **FISH Organization**, enabling us to assist people in crisis situations.

Items we accept:

- **Clothing** (clean, useable coats, hats, mittens, socks, shoes, boots, shirts, slacks, dresses, skirts, baby & maternity clothes, underwear – all in good repair)
- **Household Items** (tablecloths, napkins, blankets, sheets, fabric draperies/curtains, nic-nacs)
- **Kitchen Items** (pots, pans, dishes, silverware, serving utensils, glassware)
- **Personal Items** (jewelry, purses, wallets, sunglasses)
